To Our Residents' Family Members:

This week, all residents and staff continue to be negative for COVID-19. Residents are monitored daily for signs and symptoms, and staff are tested weekly.

The nursing staff has begun giving the flu vaccine to residents who have chosen to receive it. Staff are also in the process of receiving the flu vaccine.

Visitation remains the same currently. We must remind all family members and friends that outdoor garden visits need to be scheduled at least 24 hours in advance. During the visit, two people may participate in the weekly visit which must be a maximum of 15-20 minutes in length. We understand that these restrictions are not ideal, but they are necessary to keep your loved ones safe and healthy. Once new visitation guidelines have been released by the NJ Department of Health, we will notify you immediately.

We are still working to fully complete the COVID-19 page of our website, but the outbreak plan and information about the teleconference are available on the website. The teleconferences will begin next Tuesday 10/13/2020. Please keep an eye on our website for more exciting changes.
