To Our Residents' Family Members:

What a tumultuous week! But thankfully, everyone is healthy and safe, even those who have tested positive. Since our last letter on 12/1/2020, we have had an additional staff member and one assisted living resident test positive for COVID-19. All staff members that tested positive recently have been retested, and they are all negative as of today. All positive staff members continue to quarantine in their homes as a precaution. The assisted living resident that tested positive is asymptomatic and was given a COVID-19 rapid antigen test last night. The resident's rapid test result was negative. To be safe and follow our Outbreak Plan, we have still moved this resident to our isolation area where monitoring for signs and symptoms will occur.

All other residents and staff remain negative for COVID-19. Residents continue to be monitored for symptoms daily. Staff are tested with COVID-19 rapid antigen tests every other day as well as PCR (laboratory) tests between three to seven days from last PCR test.

Unfortunately, visitation continues to be restricted. If you would like to have a phone call or FaceTime call with your loved one, please do not hesitate to reach out to us to schedule.
