To Our Residents' Family Members:

This week, all residents remain negative for COVID-19 and continue to be monitored for signs and symptoms daily. One assisted living staff member tested positive today, December 11, with the COVID-19 rapid antigen test. She was sent home immediately to quarantine, and she is asymptomatic. A PCR test was taken and sent to the laboratory. We expect the results in the next couple days.

Monday, December 14, is the last day of the pilot program in which staff are tested every other day with the COVID-19 rapid antigen tests. Staff will continue to be tested weekly with the PCR tests. Vendors will still be tested with the COVID-19 rapid antigen test on site prior to entering the building.

Window visits for *nursing home* residents will resume Saturday, December 12. Please call at least an hour in advance to schedule your visit. Unfortunately, indoor and outdoor visits are still restricted. Phone calls and FaceTime calls are still available.

If you would like to bring in Christmas decorations or a small Christmas tree for your loved one, please feel free. We will help to set up any décor, if needed.
